



## Are you ready to grow your own cannabis under the Cannabis Act?

I have an existing and active medical document with Natural Health Services that has been written within two (2) months of my Grow at Home appointment.<sup>1</sup>

I have not been convicted, as an adult, of a designated cannabis offense that was committed while I was authorized to produce cannabis under the Act, other than under the former Marihuana Medical Access Regulations, MMAR within the preceding ten years.

The property I intend to produce plants, if growing is to take place entirely outdoors or partly outdoors, does not have any point in common with the boundary of the land on which a school, public playground, day-care facility, or other public place frequented mainly by persons under 18 years of age is located.

I have an original police document (if applicable<sup>2</sup>).

### Determine Application Type

I'm submitting a new application

I'm submitting a renewal application

I'm submitting an amendment

I have provided a description of the proposed changes (e.g. prescription increase)

I have provided a reason for the proposed changes (e.g. I would like to begin juicing my cannabis)

I have completed the "Access to Cannabis for Medical Purposes Regulations Production for Own Medical Purposes and Production by a Designated Person Registration" form and all applicable fields are complete.

I have completed and signed my [Personal Production Registration form](#).

My designated grower has completed and signed the [Designated Production Registration form](#).

I've printed the completed application

I've booked my Grow at Home appointment with Natural Health Services.

<sup>1</sup> To ensure your medical document doesn't expire while the application is under review. It is advised to submit your application with the most recent medical document possible. Health Canada's processing times may vary and approval can take up to 6 months to receive.

<sup>2</sup> You only require a police report if you wish to become a designated grower on the behalf of another patient. A patient does not require a police report to grow for themselves.
